
## **Events in the Newel K. Whitney Store**

The Newel K. Whitney store, located at the four corners area in Kirtland, was built between 1826 and 1827. Many important things took place there, including the following:

- Joseph and Emma Smith lived there beginning in the fall of 1832.
- The store became the headquarters of the Church.
- Joseph Smith III was born there on 6 November 1832.
- The School of the Prophets, which commenced on 24 January 1833 and ended sometime in April, was held there,
- Many revelations were given there to the Prophet Joseph Smith, including Doctrine and Covenants 84, 87–89, 95, and 98.
- For a time the store was used as the bishops' storehouse.
- Joseph Smith completed much of the translation of the Bible there.

In 1979 the Church acquired the Newel K. Whitney store and soon after began to restore it. The building was dedicated 25 August 1984 by President Gordon B. Hinckley.
